
Glenbard West High School 670 Crescent Blvd., Glen Ellyn, IL Live Life Well Health Fair Thursday, February 22 7:30 am – 2:30 pm.

In partnership with 90 health and service providers, Jack's Fund will be participating in Glenbard West High School's Live Life Well Health Fair. Our "See Spot" booth will offer information on sun safety, including interactive activities and giveaways for the over 2000 students and general public who will attend the fair.

In order to demonstrate the importance of early detection, three local physicians will provide free skin cancer screenings and answer questions about the causes of skin cancer.

For those brave enough to view the sun damage that has already taken place on their face, representatives from Schering Plough Corporation will provide the use of a Dermascan machine.

"A Tan to Die For", a graphic depiction of the dangers of tanning will send out a strong caution especially to our teen population, about the dangers of harmful UV radiation found through use of tanning beds. If you are under 30 and use tanning beds regularly (10 times or more per year) your risk of developing melanoma is increased nearly 8 times. Tanning lamps are to skin cancer what cigarettes are to lung cancer. To help ensure future generations are melanoma free, we will provide safe alternatives to both indoor and outdoor tanning as well.
