



How to Use Real Time Video On Your Crowdrise Page:

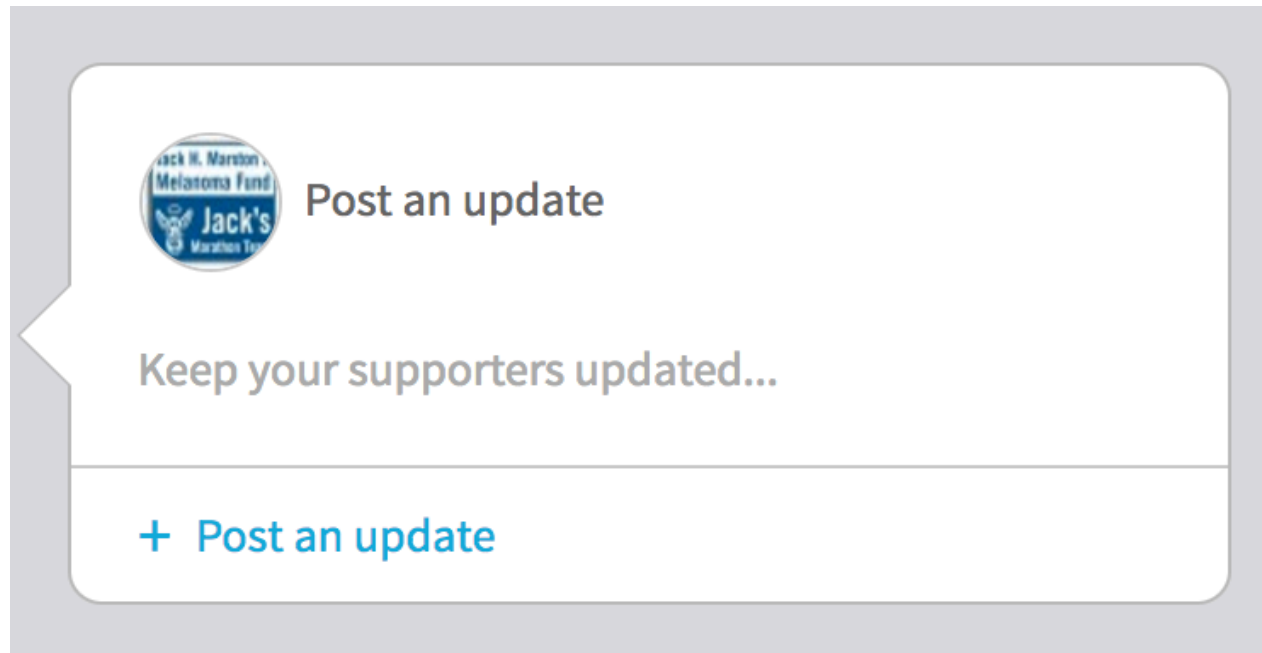
Keep your donors engaged!

POST AN UPDATE:

On any fundraiser page, you'll see the '*post an update*' box



Click the **blue + post an update**.
This will take you to a new screen.
This screen is where you can add the title and text,
along with the pic and video feature.


